It is not in the Berlin list, and was not known to Mr Newberry. But it was known to the natives, though the information of Hassan Cimpisa varied from day to day κατά καιρῶν. Probably there is another tomb to the S. W. of it (i. e. under the enclosure wall) - as <since from> the most southern chamber of opening from the well in the right transept there is a rubbish slide from above.
