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on the luggage carrier. fortunately there are no hills on the way to the station or some of us would have had to get out & walk. When we got to the station we found the train would be an hour late, so we unpacked Sylvia's portable gramophone that she had brought & had a concert on the station, we wonder what the native population thought of Caesar Frank (spelling uncertain).
