I am glad you are pleased with the information about native weaving etc that I have been able to gather here, just wait until you see the work they can produce with these primitive tools! I am enclosing the pictures I took in the weaver's house. The photo of the loom is very successful considering it was such a dark corner & I had to make a time exposure. The weaver's son is working at the loom. you will see the old man himself sitting beside the skein winder. doesn't he make a beautiful picture. (Kodaks have made me an enlargement of it.) The picture of the little boy actually working the winder is slightly blurred owing to the movement I should have made it  $\frac{1}{50}$  of a second instead of  $\frac{1}{25}$ . I hope you like the picture of Sardic flirting with the lady camel. isn't she sweet, just look at the love light in her eyes. (she was also dribbling but this doesn't show in the photo)
