I think that the people who print that sort of thing are either Curwen or the Oxford Press (I know Mr Johnson the head of the Clarendon Press personally “Printer to the University” he is called) I think the 4 movements <sup>full score</sup> take up about 24 pages with 5 lines to a page but as I haven't the score here I can't be quite sure – I<sup>sic</sup> {A} number of people have enquired after it & it might be simpler to have it printed than to go on having copies made – which are expensive – if its<sup>sic</sup> too costly printing I shall not go ahead of course –
