Arabah [late (between 21 and 27) February 1931]

Dear Father.

I want the smallest made & one each of the next 3 sizes, either 00 - 0 - 1 - 2. or 0 - 1 - 2 - 3. I am not certain how they are numbered. While you are there you might tell them I am finding the camera lucida very useful.

I think it would be best if you posted the brushes yourself – send them "sample post" so as to avoid bother with the customs.

I think I would also like one of the smallest size miniature brushes & one of the next size. the detail we have to put in is so tiny that one needs the wee'st brushes made. & one needs some with the usual length hair & some short, the miniature are
