April 11th [1933]

Dear Mother.

I had unexpected visitors this week, Sunday afternoon our police officer came in to say there was an English officer & his wife who wanted to camp somewhere in the desert for two nights & would I allow them to put their tent near the house. so I asked him to bring them into the temple & I would talk to them. they came along & introduced themselves he is stationed near Suez Canal for a year, & having two months^{sic} leave thought they would take the opportunity of seeing Egypt & being hard up wanted to do it as cheaply as possible, so they bought a car 8th hand for £25

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 packed their kit, a puppy & the smallest
 thing in native servants they could
 get. (age 10) & started off. knowing
 hardly any Arabic & nothing of the
 country but having a good time
 in spite of many difficulties.


I sent one of the men along to show
 them the way. & when I finished
 work for the day & returned to the
 house I found them comfortably
 installed, the car forming a wind
 screen & one side of a tiny tent thus →



I found Nannie had
 made them tea &
 was enjoying a good gossip. I offered
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 they were dreadfully afraid of being
 a bother & after a lot of pressing
 accepted an invitation to have
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so Nannie had a chicken killed & produced a very nice meal which they thoroughly appreciated. & this morning our men filled up their water tank & they proceeded on their way to Luxor.

It was such fun having them. they were such a jolly couple. of course I sent old Ahmed to act as guide & show them all the local sights. They knew nothing of Egyptian History or Art or anything Egyptological but were thoroughly interested & thrilled by all they saw just the same. Our men made a great fuss of their little servant. they called him Benjamin because he was the smallest. he knew about a dozen words of English but he was a bright lad & they seemed to make
